### What is Political Theory-Science and Why do we need Political Science

Human beings are physical creatures as part of physical universe therefore all are subject of laws. Political science deals a range of concepts embedded in practices. For example, it deals concepts related to justice, rights, liberty, equality, democracy, theories and so on.

#### The distinctiveness of theory-

Philosopher or a theorist tries to answer big questions like what is justice, social reform, equality and job of theorist is to achieve and articulate entire concepts related to the issue. It is first kind of feature of theory.

Second, theorist tries to make issue rational and reasonable. For example, education is need of children. If there is no education society would be corrupt and meaningless. Therefore we see that education is reasonable.

Third, feature of theory is aspiration to truth and objectivity. Theorist tries to seek and explore what should be reality. For example, Plato trying to produce various such questions while dealing other significant issues of that time.
